



Reflection: I am gentle and humble in heart

To encounter God requires only one thing. Not intellectual prowess, worldly excellence, or sophisticated achievements, but *simplicity*. Chandeliers: Quite a few people have commented on the chandeliers at St John's. They arouse strong feelings but most, at least, agree that they are too low. We raised them by 800mm (32 inches) on Wednesday. Those who have noticed have been pleased that the crucifix can now be seen when entering the Church and the screen is more visible (although

there are still some blind spots) and they look like they are at the right height now. What do you think? We might move them a touch higher when scaffolding for painters is in place.
